

Abbey Primary School Sports Premium Action Plan 2016-17 Academic Year

Sports Premium Information

Schools receive PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in years 1 to 6. How many pupils that attract the funding is found by using data from the January 2016 school census.

Funding for 2016 to 2017

Schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils receive £500 per pupil.

Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 and an additional payment of £5 per pupil.

Overall Focus

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer. This could be used for the following:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers
- make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years, e.g. hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers, provide existing staff with training or resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively, introduce new sports or activities and encourage more pupils to take up sport, support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs, holiday clubs and [Change4Life](#) clubs, run sport competitions, run sports activities with other schools,
